

## "Love God, your God, with your whole heart: love Him with all that's in you, love Him with all you've got!

Talk about them wherever you are, sitting at home or walking in the street; talk about them from the time you get up in the morning to when you fall into bed at night. Tie them on your hands and foreheads as a reminder; inscribe them on the doorposts of your homes and on your city gates."

Deuteronomy 6:5-9

Recently I helped my son do a compare and contrast essay for school. He had to come up with a thesis for the comparison of a book and a movie. The thesis that he derived from his reading and watching was that one of the things that determines the path of a young man or woman is the influence of a caring and loving father. Twenty-eight percent of all children in the world live without their biological father, 24.7 million of those live in America.

Every day that we counsel we see the influence, both good and bad of fathers in people's lives. What words do your children need to hear from you to succeed? One of the most important things a child needs is to know they are loved and accepted. "I love you." "I was wrong, will you forgive me?" "I'm proud of you." The word "No". The word "Yes". "Let's pray." "How can I help you?" "Do you feel loved by me?" "When do you feel loved by me?" "What is your biggest fear?" :What do you struggle with the most?"

What is scary for fathers is that children tend to look at God the same way they perceive their fathers. If a father tends to be harsh and unloving, then the children will feel that God is harsh and unloving. If a father is kind and understanding that's the way the child will view God. If we are going to love our children so they see God in a proper light, we need to care for and understand their hearts and what is going on inside. Let's turn our hearts toward the hearts of our children.
