We've had a busy Spring. We attended the CFTH director's conference in Hesston, Kansas in April, where we were blessed by the ministry of Bob Moeller from Chicago, who shared some amazing insights about the relationship between Jacob & Leah and how it applies to our own relationship as a married couple. We also had the privilege of presenting a workshop on the Parenting Material.

We have started conducting parenting seminars entitled "Cooperation, Consequences and Keeping Your Sanity." In the last few months, seminars have been held in Listowel, Aylmer and Shelburne. The In-depth Training Seminar was held at our home office in Wingham at the end of May, with attendees from Manitoba, Michigan and Ontario. Four of the trainees were pastors who will be sharing what they have learned with those to whom they minister. We are passionate about getting more lay people or those in church leadership interested in helping others.

Breakfast was shared with a Celebrate Recovery group of about 50 people in Chesley ON on a Saturday morning in June. We shared our testimony and Bob did some teaching as well.

Bob has continued to counsel during all of this busyness. In April, May and June he has sat with 12 couples, each one for four day sessions. In addition, he has had numerous morning appointments and phone calls.

In the last three months we've also had twelve interns in our office, from different parts of the country, who have observed the complete counselling process. Interns write a paper at the end of the week to outline their observations and the process of resolution. Bob also spends an hour with them after sessions to help them with the counselling process.

Thank you again for partnering with us - prayerfully and financially. We are looking forward to a break the middle of July.
